domogallery is pleased to announce **inscapes**, Eric Jiaju Lee's second solo show in New Jersey.

Lee's exceptional awareness of space establishes a dialog between organic and natural forms, the result of controlled improvisations. In Lee's paintings forms are manifestations emerging and submerging back into space. "My works are about an unbounded openness, an emptiness where form is most clearly understood in its relationship to space." A meticulous and minimal selection of forms allows Lee to emphasize the space. His use of raw canvas or unprinted fabric is a reminder of Nature's transience, as in the principle of change as the universal constant.

Lee uses different pouring techniques and paint viscosities to create a diverse range of qualities and effects. Lee also recently began using vertical and horizontal formats to further evoke notions of landscape.

Eric Jiaju Lee received his Master of Fine Arts degree at Hunter College in New York City. He has exhibited in New York, New Jersey and London. Many of his works are found in private collections internationally. He lives in New York and works as adjunct professor of Fine Arts and Art History at the County College of Morris in New Jersey.
